Note 1: Reference as to Shares (item 6):

- (a) in relation to an application with a share capital, refer to allotted shares;
- (b) in relation to an applicant with capital, refers to rights shares in the capital of the applicant; or
- (c) in relation to an application without capital, refers to interests:
 - (i) conferring any right to share in the profits or liability to contribute to the losses of the applicant; or
 - (ii) giving rise to an obligation to contribute to the debts or expenses of the applicant in the event of a winding up.
- Note 2: The description required under item 7 should enable the areas, location or premises concerned to be adequately and readily identified, by map if the applicant so desires or by any other convenient means. The following examples of descriptions that might be used are not exhaustive and are by way of illustration only. The area or premises might be identified by the name or the customers and/or normal postal address of the premises to be supplied; described by reference to a named street or road, town, city, village, district or other accepted boundary, such as Local Authority area or described by reference to certain other characteristics such as the type of the premises or the maximum electrical demand to be met at those premises.

- 3. Details of any expected subsequent substantial capital outflows including major decommissioning costs.
- 4. Estimates of net annual cash flows for subsequent periods sufficient to demonstrate the financial security and feasibility of the project(s) to which the application relates.
